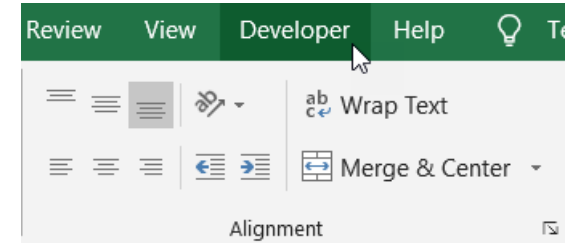

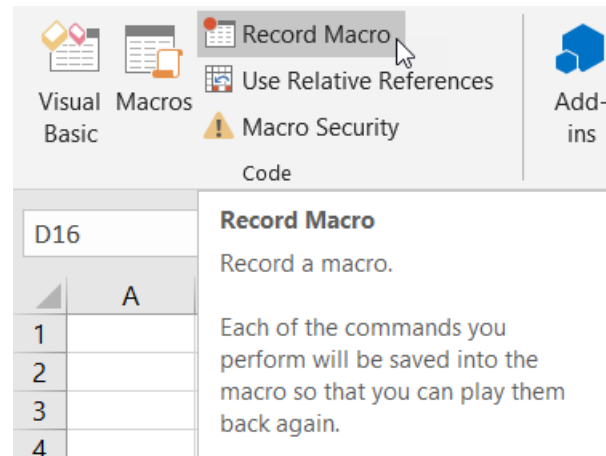
1. Open Excel



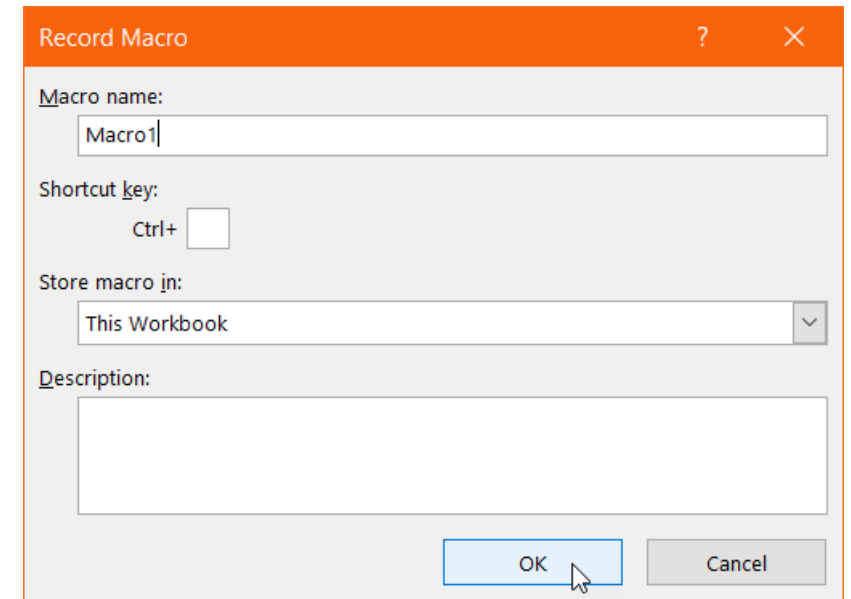
2. Select the Developer Tab



3. Click Record Macro to start recording your actions in Excel



4. The Record Macro popup appears. Presenting an opportunity to Enter a Macro Name, Shortcut Key, Store Macro In, and Description. Click Ok



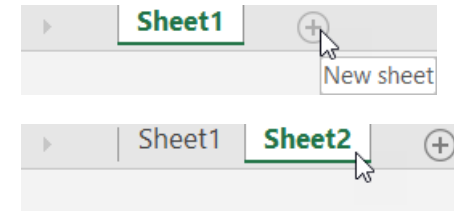

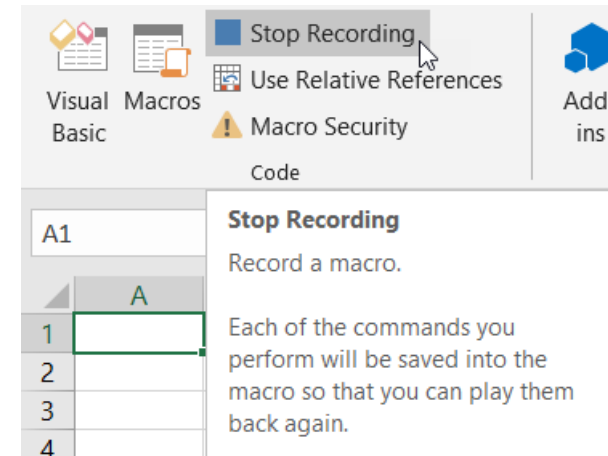

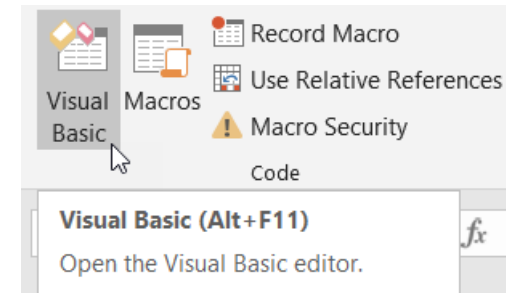
5. All actions taken in Excel will be recorded. Click New sheet

6. Click Stop Recording to save this action in the Macro Recorder



7. Open Visual Basic



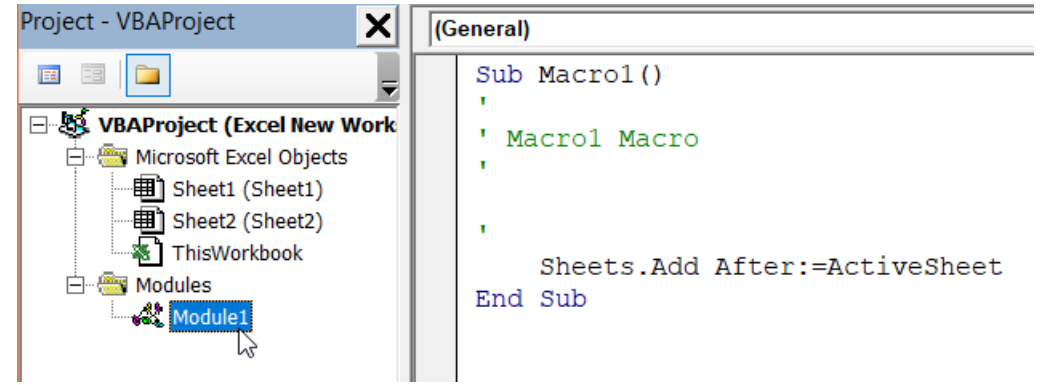

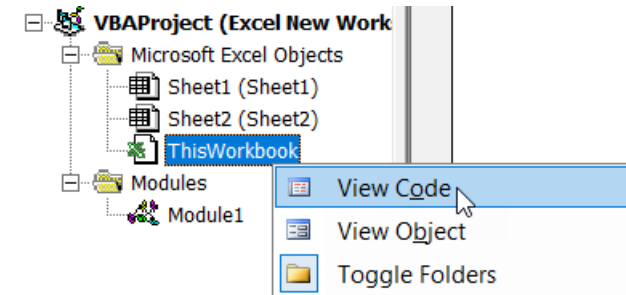
8. Navigate to Modules and select Module1. You will see Macro1



9. Select the following code and copy it

```
Sub Macro1 ()  
    ' Macro1 Macro  
  
    Sheets.Add After:=ActiveSheet  
End Sub
```

10. Right Click ThisWorkbook and select View Code

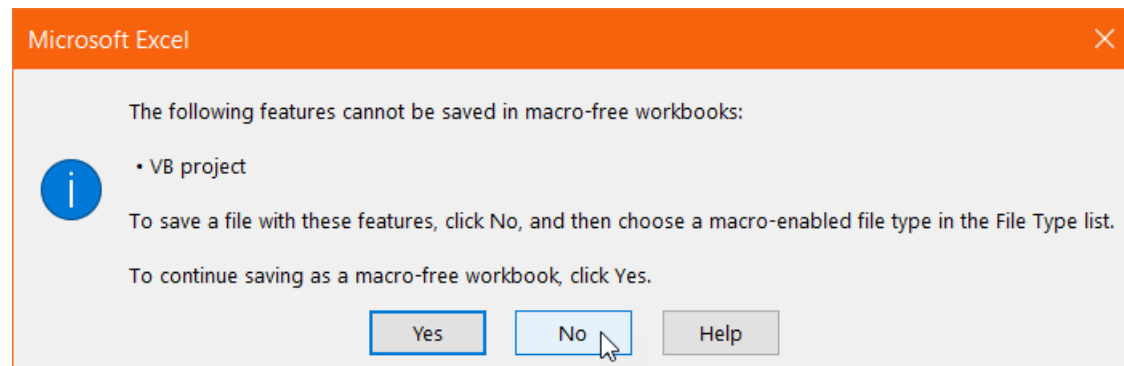
11. Type the following code

```
Workbook  
Sub Workbook_Open()  
|  
End Sub
```

12. Paste in the copied code

```
Workbook  
Sub Workbook_Open()  
  Sheets.Add After:=ActiveSheet  
End Sub
```

13. When attempting to save or exit Visual Basic a popup appears. Click No





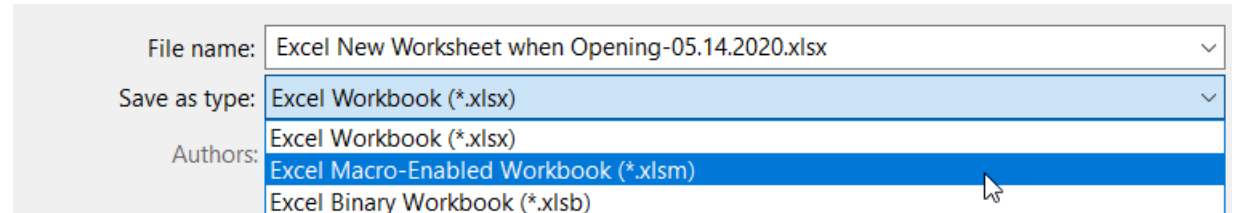

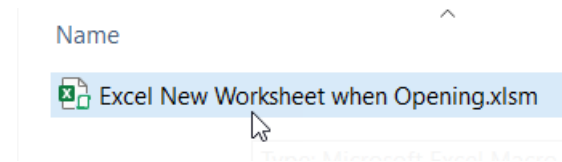

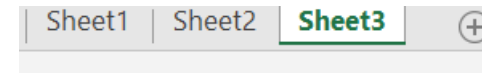
14. Select Excel Macro-Enabled Workbook (*.xlsm) Click Save
